General Information:

What to bring:

Each child will be given a ToonieKids Week bag upon their arrival. They will be able to keep their belongings in this during the week. Please note that fruit and snacks will be provided for morning tea each day. Please bring...

- Water bottle
- Hat

We recommend that children wear joggers, comfortable clothes, and sunscreen. Please do not wear expensive clothing or bring any valuables, electronic game consoles, mobile phones, cameras or jewellery.

Lost property:

Lost property will be placed in a box at the rego desk. We will try to return items that are clearly labelled. Lost property will be held until the end of the July school holiday period. Please contact the office to arrange a time to check and collect any lost items.

Sick Children:

No child will be admitted to ToonieKids Week if they are showing any signs of illness on arrival. The director will discuss any actions with the accompanying adult on arrival. If you are unsure whether your child may attend please call the director on the day in question, between 8:00-8:30 am to discuss. If a child becomes ill during the ToonieKids Week program, parents will be contacted to collect their child. In the event of an accident, first aid will be administered by first aid trained team members and an ambulance will be called if necessary. Should transportation to the hospital be required a ToonieKids Week leader will travel with your child until such time as their parent can take over.

Medical Information:

Regular medication, Epipens, asthma puffers, antibiotics, and any other medication that may be required during ToonieKids Week will need to be dropped off each day with your child's group leader. All known medical conditions need to be disclosed during the registration process.













Additional Support:

We recognise that the needs of individual children vary and we will endeavour to accommodate children with additional needs within the ToonieKids Week program. We are realistic about the limitations of our environment for children with additional needs and attendance is considered on an individual basis and is determined by our staffing ratio and experience to ensure appropriate care is offered for all children attending.

Please contact the team prior to booking to discuss any requirements further and to consider what (if any) arrangements can and need to be put in place to care for your child.

Behaviour Expectations:

We set ourselves high standards and expect that the children attending ToonieKids Week behave in accordance: treating others, personal property and facilities with respect; listening to and following instructions from ToonieKids Week leaders. Swearing, abusive language, aggressive behaviour or violence will not be tolerated. Any failure to comply with these conditions will result in parents being asked to collect and sign out their child immediately.

Arrival and Departure Arrangements:

Doors will open at 9:00 am. The program will conclude at 12:30 pm. We cannot guarantee staffing levels beyond this finish time. Children must be signed in and out by an adult. We will not allow any child to return home unaccompanied.

Quality and Safety:

ToonieKids Week continues to operate with an exemplary health and safety record. All leaders participate in training program before the week that includes: child protection, "Working with Children Check", allergy awareness, first aid procedures, and fire and evacuation procedures. Leaders are appointed following the Kids Week Director's selection process.
